- Items may be requested by post and the borrower is asked to pay postage both ways. Some books are quite heavy and the postage may be expensive. It is suggested that a check be made at the local public library as some of the reference books may be available through the inter library loan service.
- Items borrowed to be returned within one month.
- All items borrowed remain the property of NFHS and any losses/damage will need to be paid for.
